

TRANSFER



Students planning to transfer to Virginia Wesleyan University from a college within the Virginia Community College System (VCCS) should consult the [VCCS Transfer Guide](#) for more information regarding timely degree completion. Courses in black are strongly recommended—students who do not complete these courses may require an additional year of college coursework to complete. Courses in blue are encouraged—these courses may not be required but are recommended for a smoother transition to the university.

Transfer students must complete 30 credit hours of college coursework with a grade of C or better to satisfy all of the VWSU general education program except for the junior/senior seminar (WES 300).
