Recommended Courses for Majors Planning to Transfer to VWU

Students planning to transfer to Virginia Wesleyan University from anywhere within the Virginia Community College System (VCCS) should consult with a transfer advisor at the VCCS campus from which they are transferring to ensure timely degree completion. Courses in black are strongly recommended—students who do not complete these courses may require an additional year due to course sequencing issues. Courses in blue are encouraged—transfer advisors should be consulted for more information regarding the transfer process.

Students who complete the Associate of Arts degree with sufficient grade point average will satisfy all of the VWU course requirements for the International Studies (BA) International Business Track, with the exception of the junior/senior seminar (WES 300).
